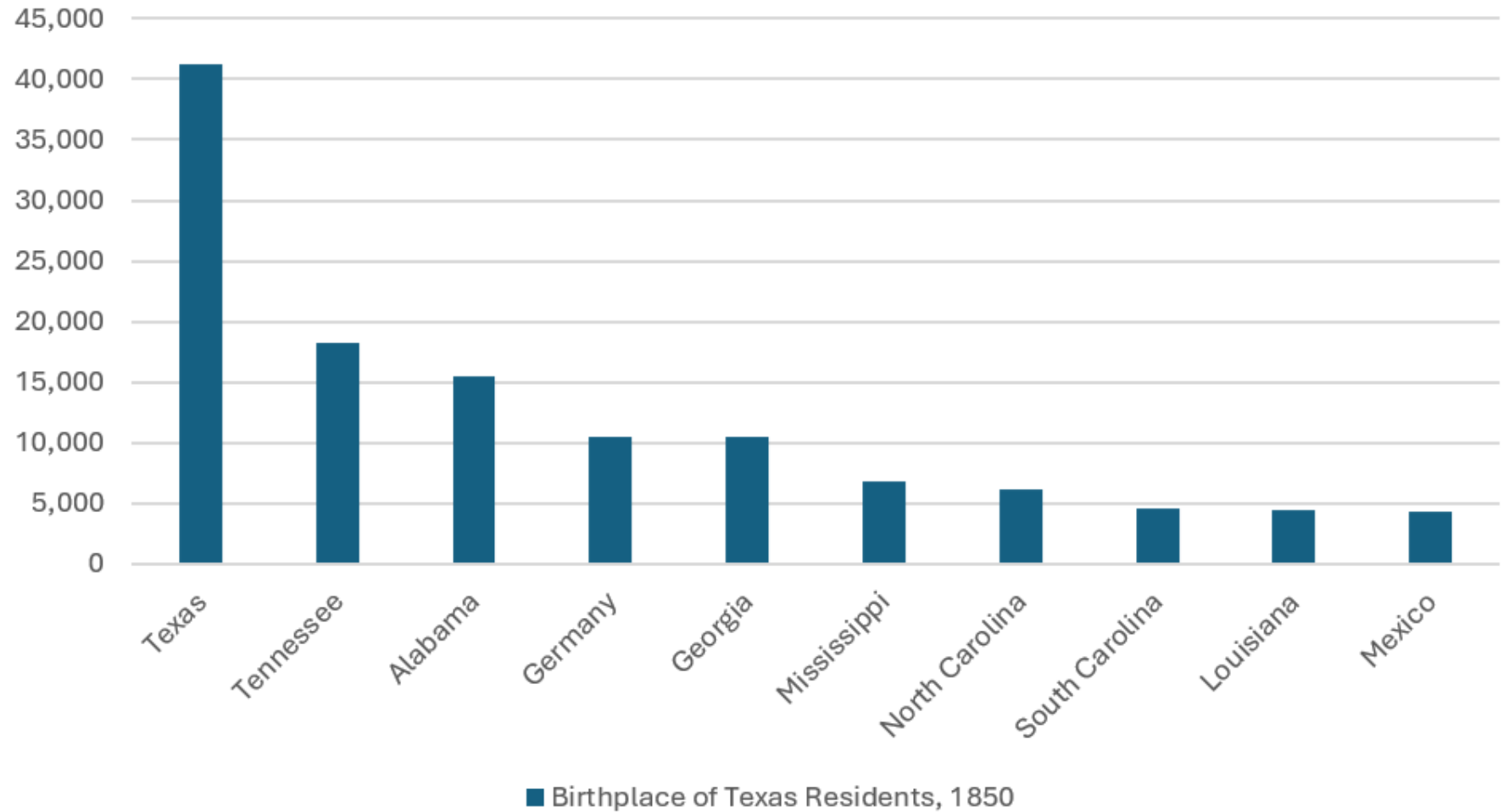
In today's lesson...

2. **I will** complete a stations activity, using materials at seven stations to answer questions about developments in Texas' population during the Early Statehood era.

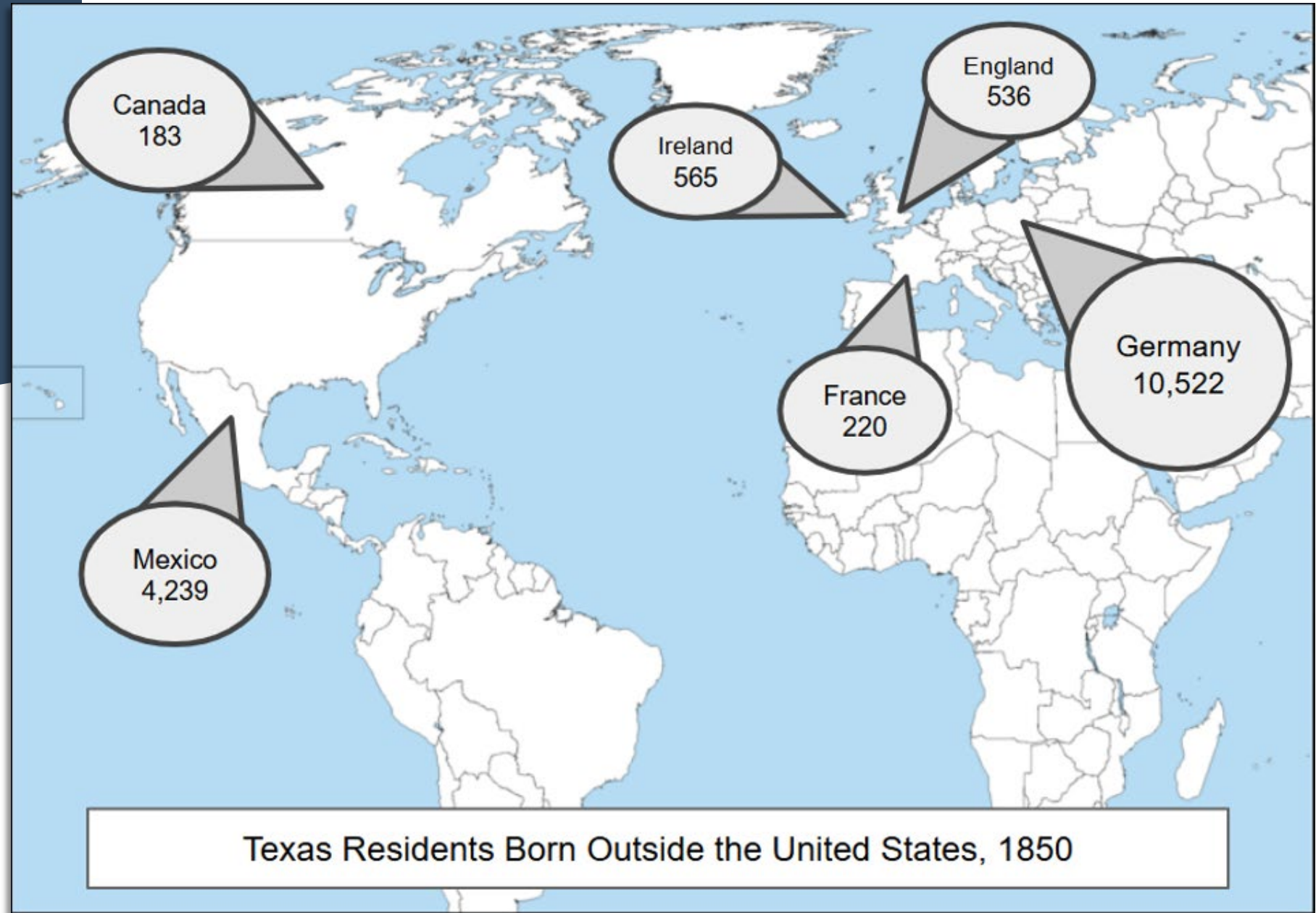

Birthplace of Texas Residents, 1850



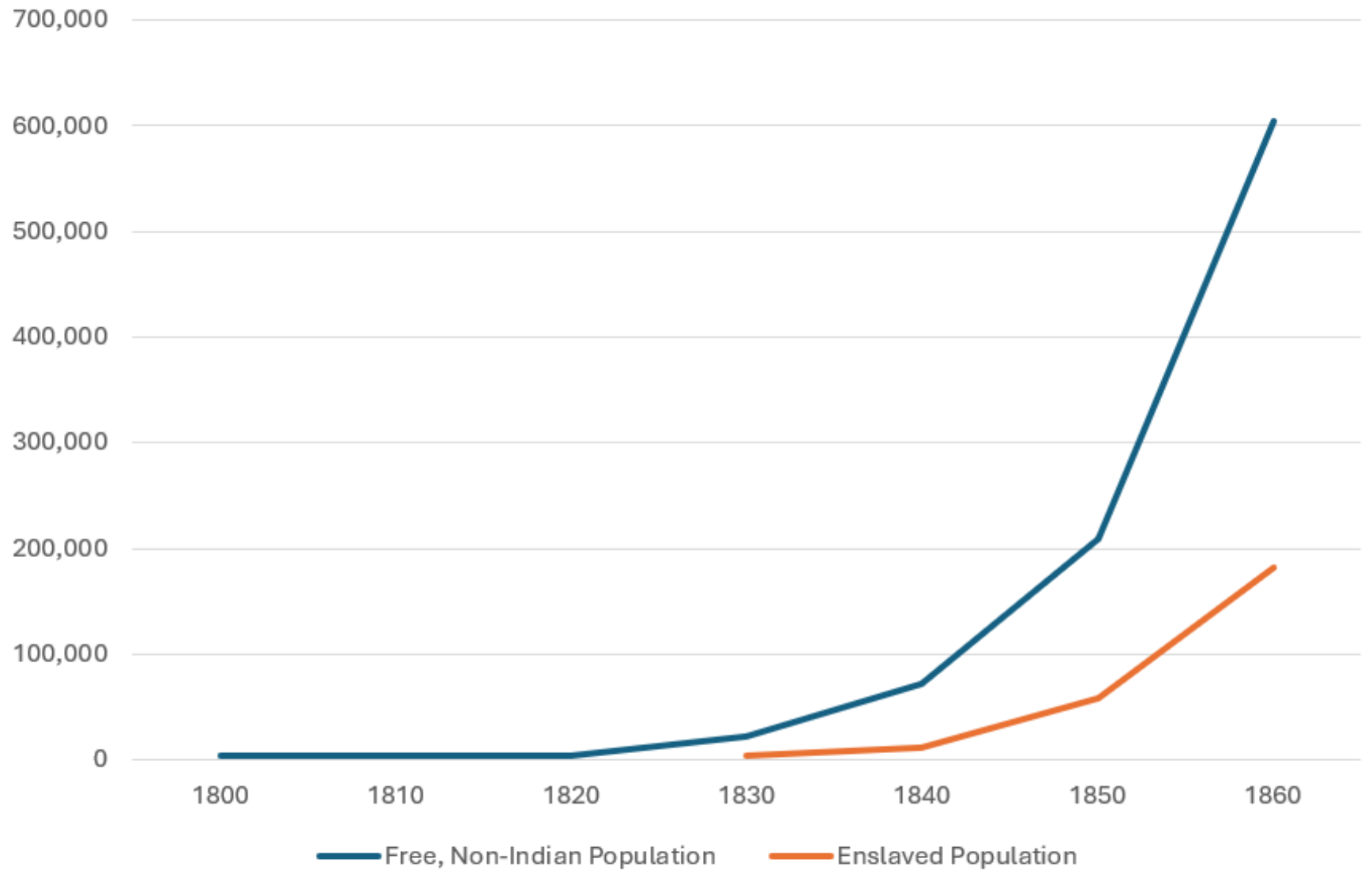
