









#### Leading U.S. Cotton Producing States, 2018 - 2020

Bales of cotton produced by the million





## Station 2 Acres of Cotton Harvested in the United States, 2017






Top 5 Most Profitable Agricultural Products





#### Cotton Planted and Harvest in Texas: 2017 - 2022


