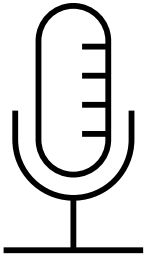

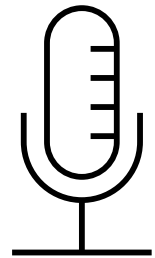

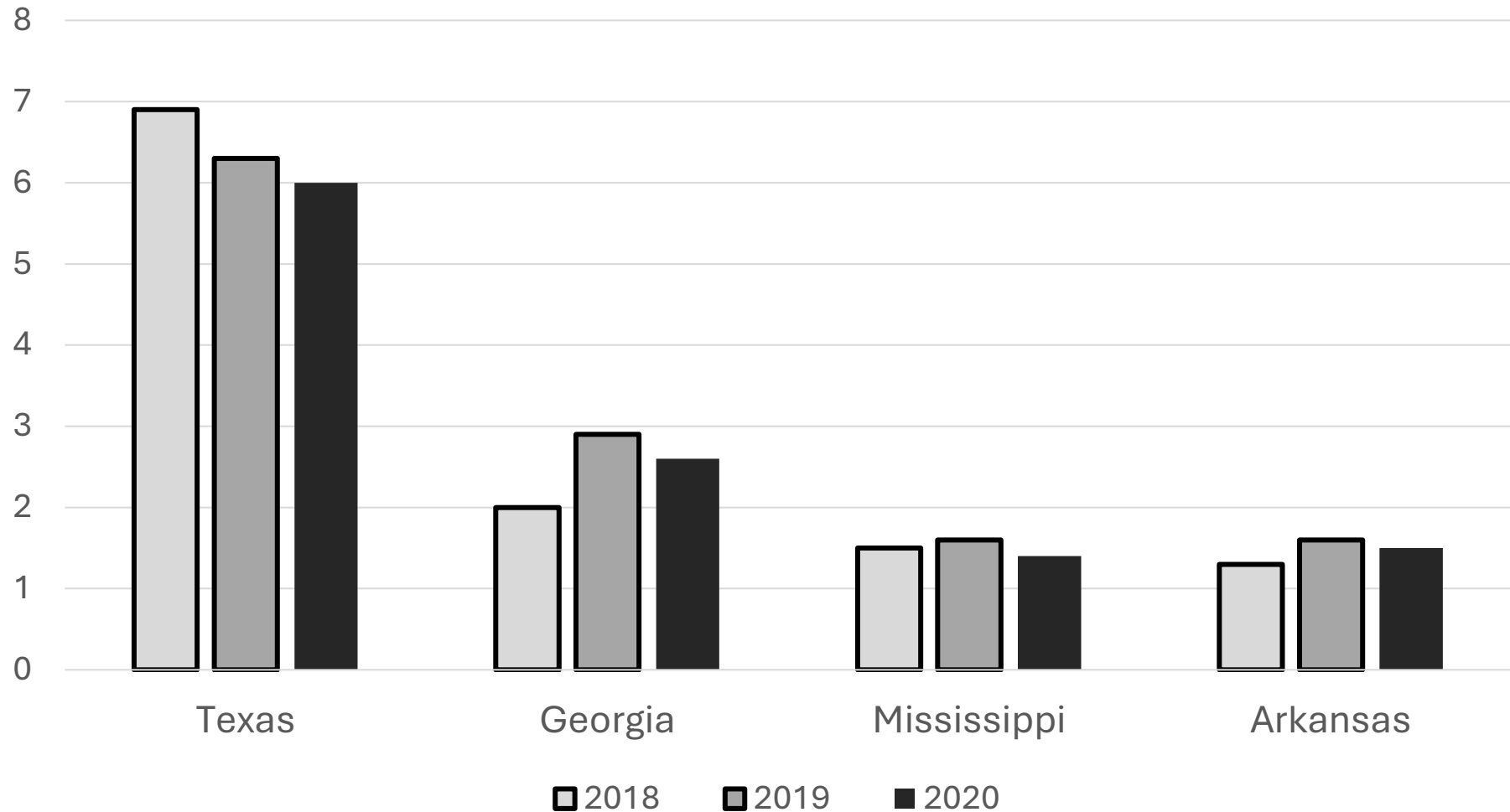

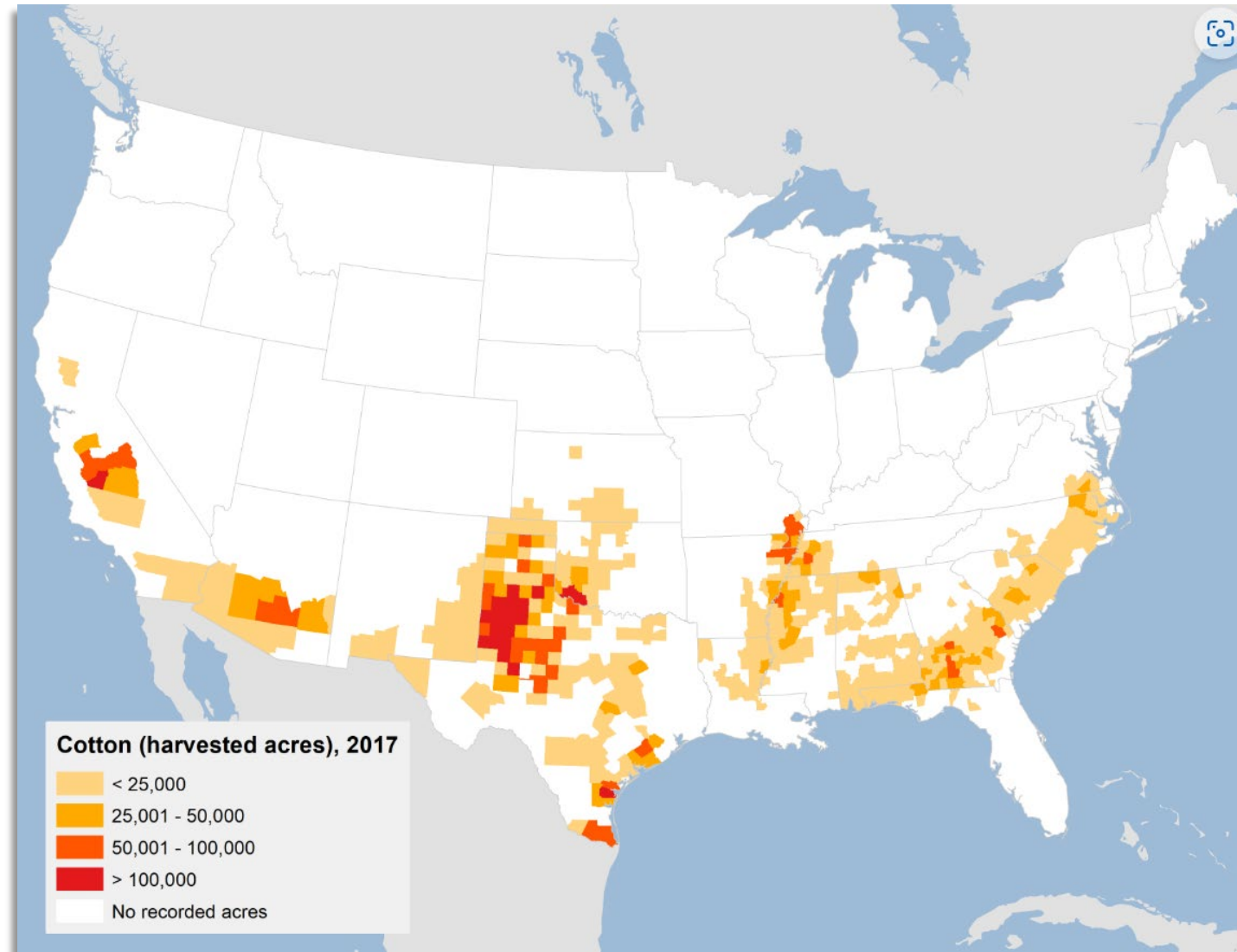
Leading U.S. Cotton Producing States, 2018 - 2020

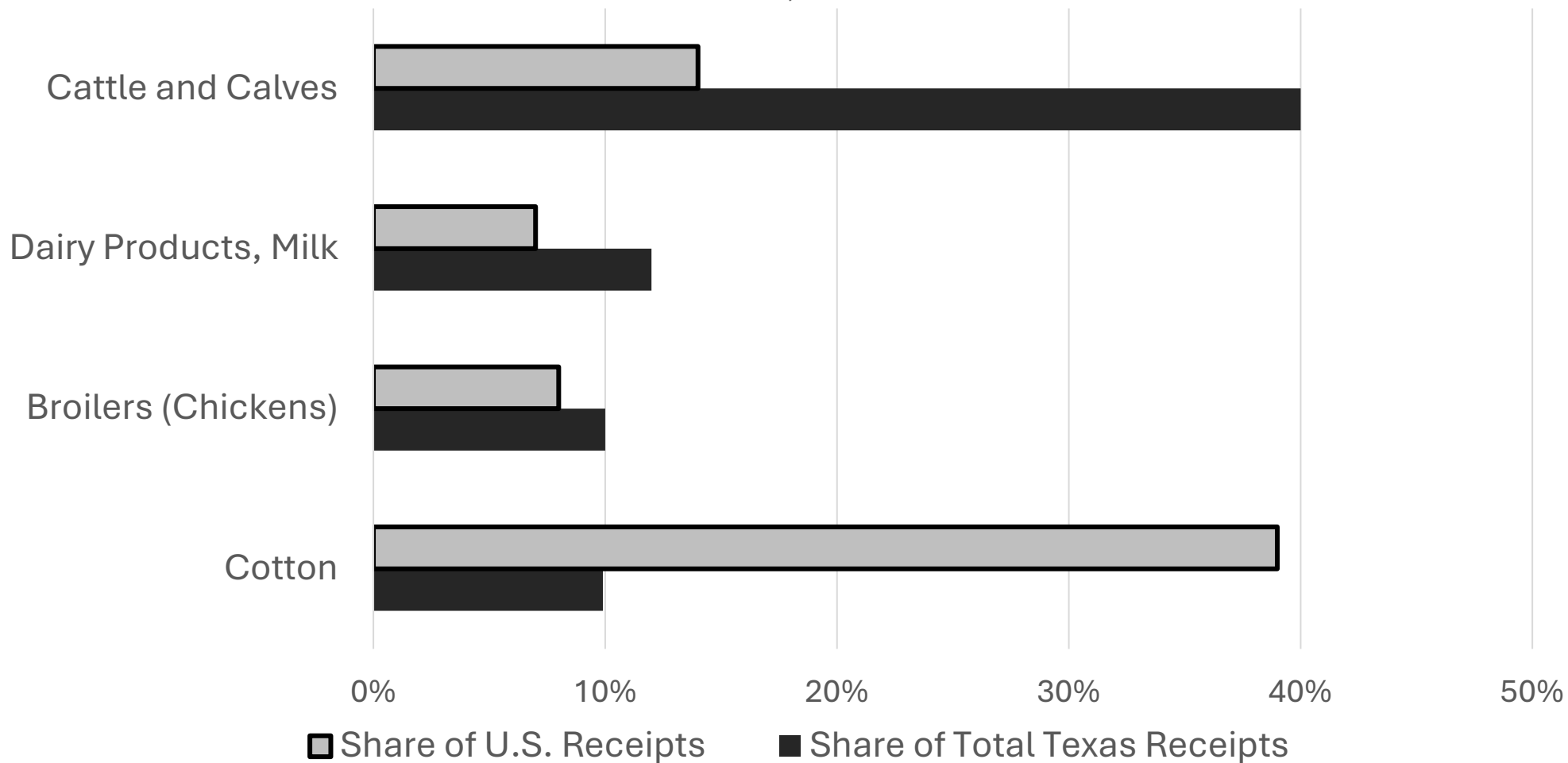
Acres of Cotton Harvested in the United States, 2017

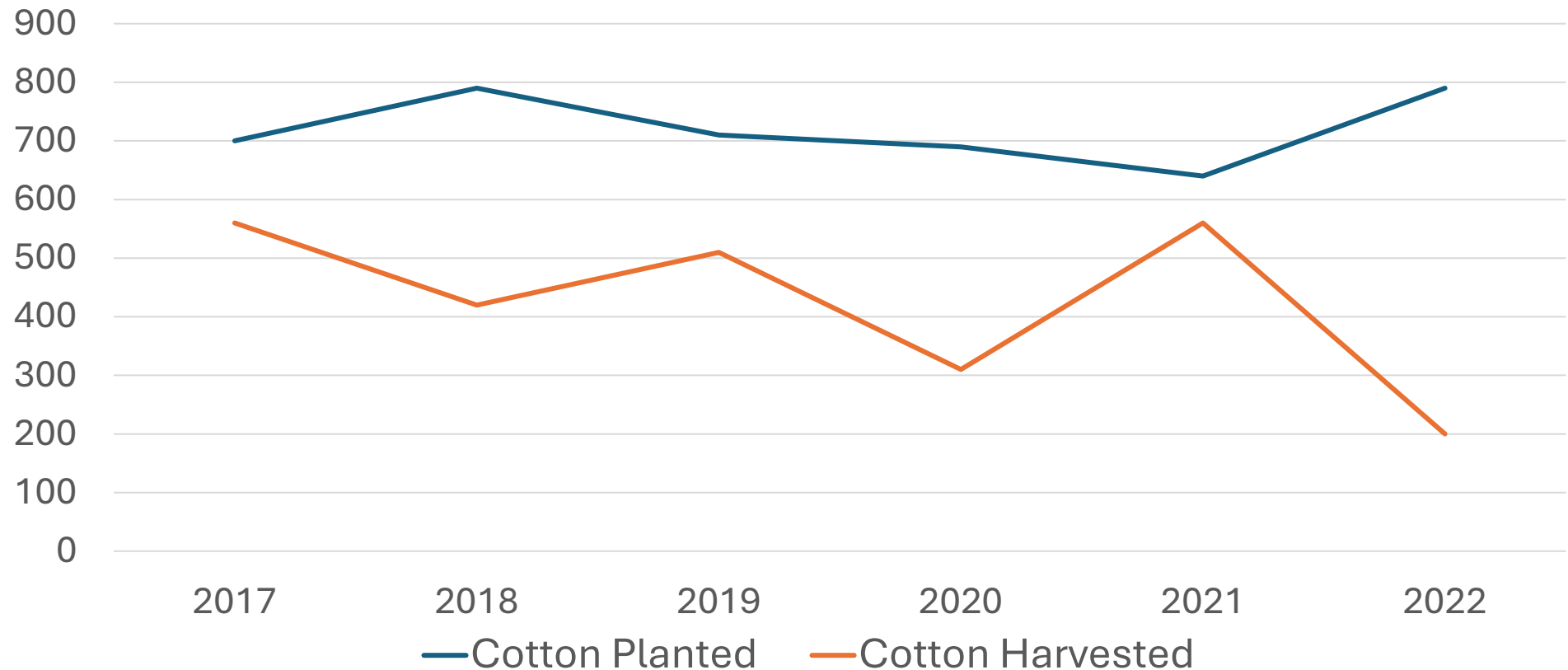

Cotton Planted and Harvest in Texas: 2017 - 2022

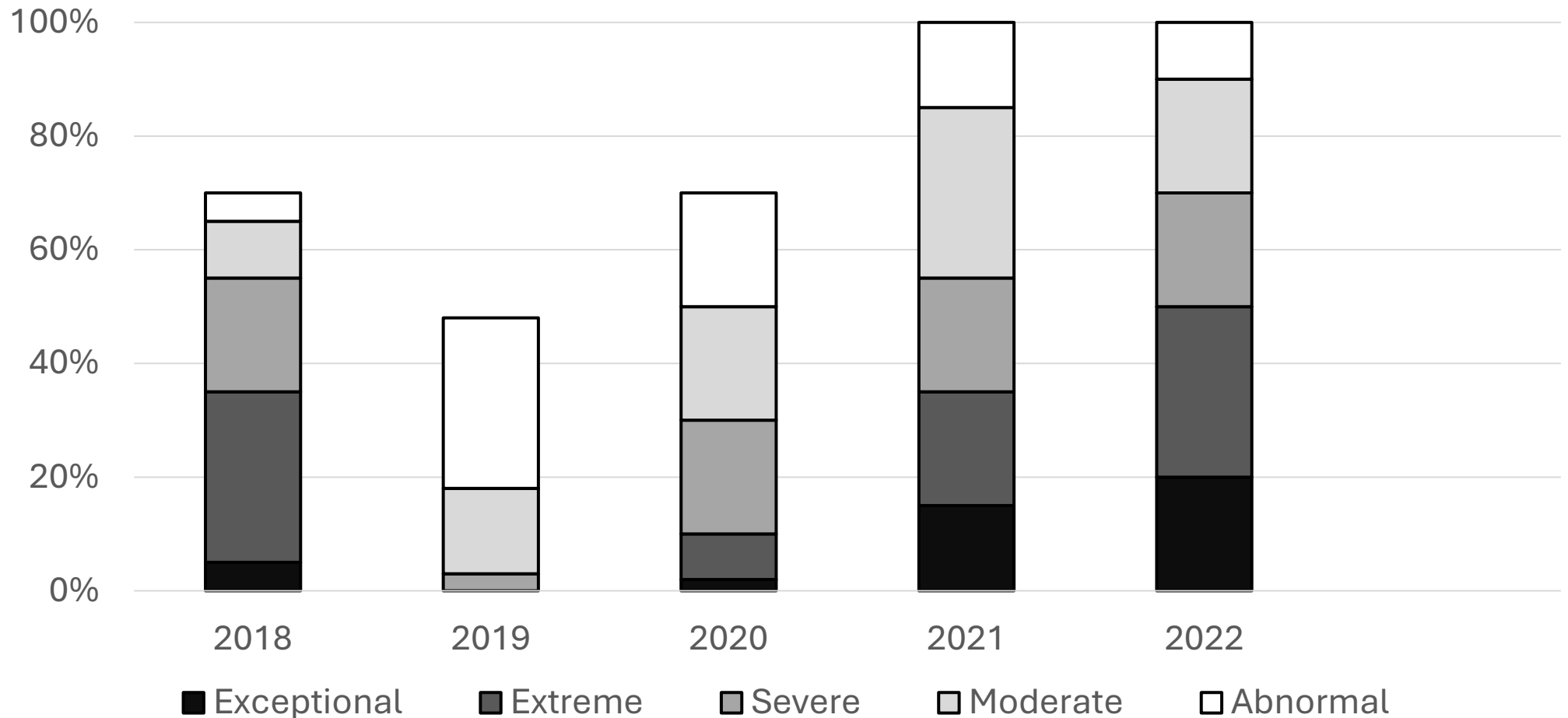
Measured by the number of pounds per acre
