You are trying to get 5 terms in a row **horizontally**, **vertically**, or **diagonally**.



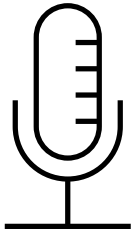
