4. Answers will vary but should include references to the following information in the passage: “Today, we believe that Shamans may have created the rock art to record their spiritual experiences in the spirit world for members of their tribe.”
5. Answer will vary but should include that the people who created the pictographs moved from the area and it has been difficult locating their descendants today to try to learn more about this artifact.
