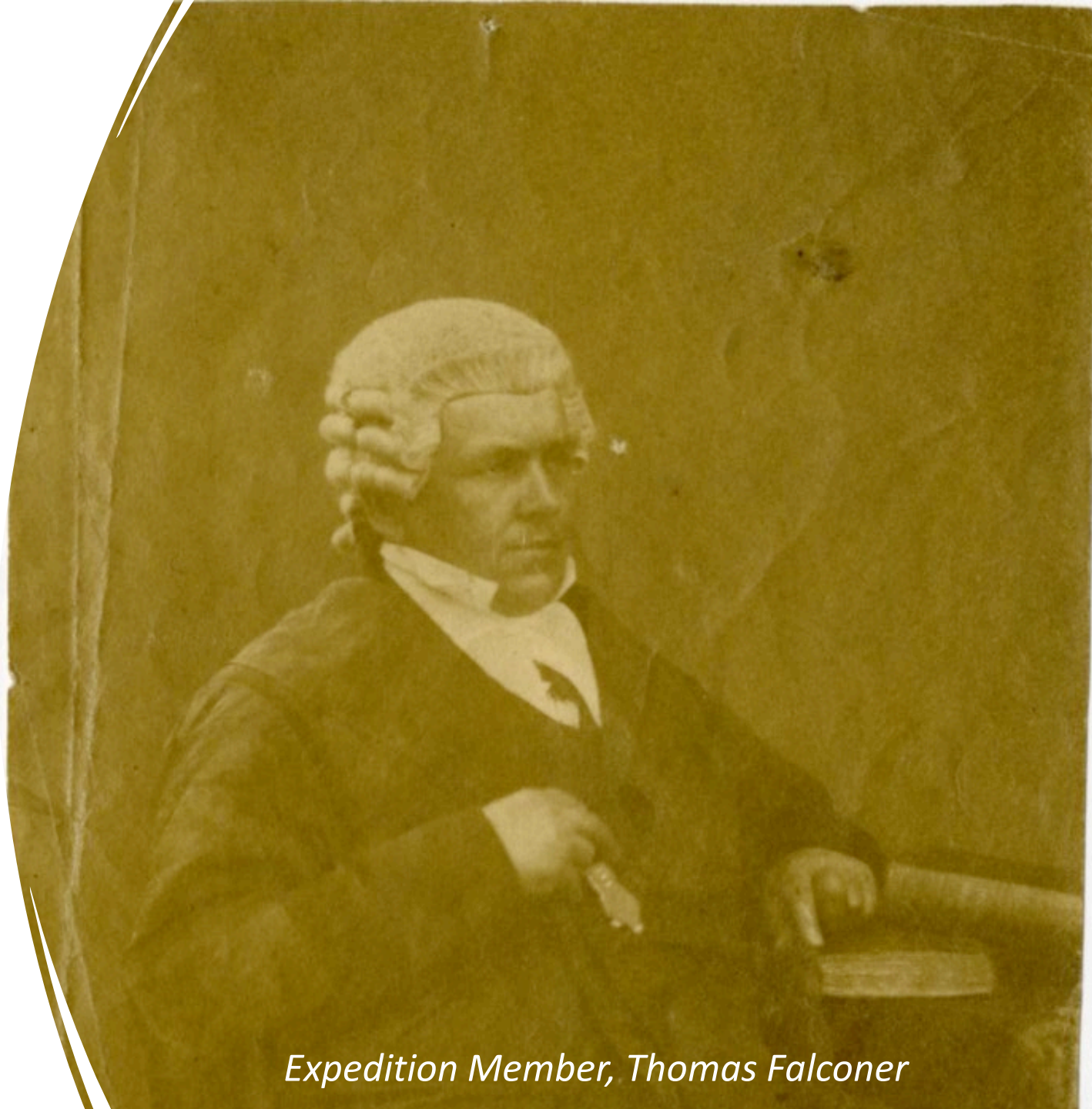

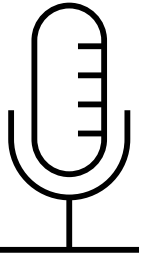

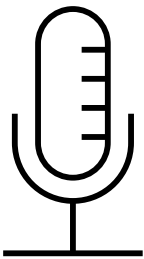

# Thomas Falconer's Account of the Santa Fe Expedition



*From the New Orleans Picayune.*  
**SANTA FÉ EXPEDITION.**

The following account of the march of the Santa Fé Expedition, has been prepared especially for this paper, by Mr. THOS. FALCONER, a gentleman who accompanied the expedition its entire march.

We left Austin on the 18th of June, 1841, for the camp at Brushy, about twelve miles off. At this place we found the expedition to Santa Fé, prepared to start. It consisted of a military force—of the merchants; and of others who had joined the expedition for the purpose of pleasure and of information—and of the commissioners. The military force was divided into six companies, under the following commands:—1st. Capt. Sutton, Lieuts. Johnson and Bur-

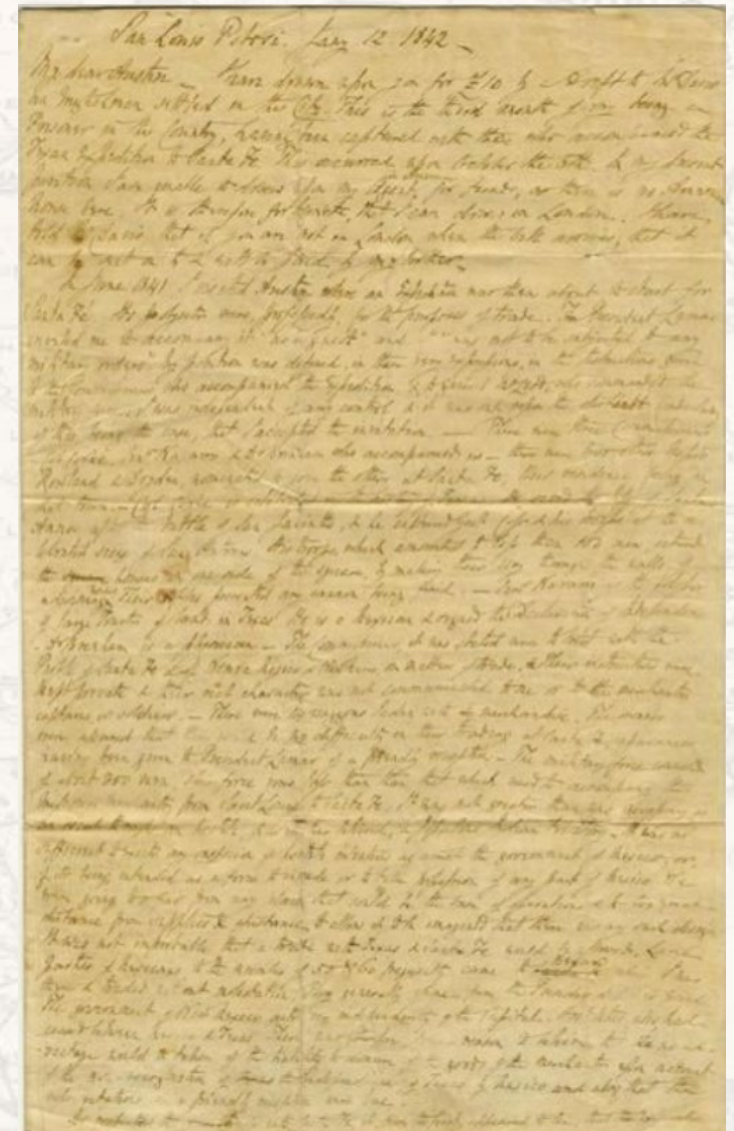
